#### **August Financial Report**

The amount of temporarily restricted funds, including memorials, is \$85,085 and

are not available to be used for day-to-day operational expenses.

#### **Masisiwe Student Scholarships for 2022**

During the month of October we will be requesting funds for 2023 scholarships for our Masisiwe children. We have been sponsoring their secondary school education since 2005. The last year of government schooling is 6th Grade. Our support makes a significant difference for their education. Last year we raised \$6,325 that benefited 32 children! A Masisiwe parish committee determines who and how much each child receives depending on their potential and needs. Some remain in Masisiwe but the majority hope to attend Lutheran Secondary schools where board and room costs up to \$500 per year. Our mission teams have visited the schools in Bomalang'ombe and Pommern. We have had many students advance beyond Form V into vocational school, college and seminary. This education benefits the entire village!

Change can be challenging, but I invite us to see it as an opportunity to shine as Christ's disciples. I am reminded of a beautiful prayer from theologian and Trappist monk, Thomas Merton:

My Lord God, I have no idea where I am going. I do not see the road ahead of me. I cannot know for certain where it will end. Nor do I think I really know myself, and the fact that I think I am following your will does not mean that I am actually doing so. But I believe that the desire to please you does in fact please you. And I hope I have that desire in all that I am doing. I hope that I will never do anything apart from that desire. And I know that if I do this you will lead me by the right road, though I may know nothing about it. Therefore I will trust you always though I may seem to be lost and in the shadow of death. I will not fear, for you are ever with me, and you will never leave me to face my perils alone.

Although change can bring anxiety, it can also bring excitement, hope, and renewal. Let us keep our faith that all will work out for the best and let us especially welcome Pastor Sarah as only we at Christ the King can – for her shepherding of our congregation during our search for our new call pastor.
