# Worship and Scripture

After our long journey with Jesus in Luke's Gospel, a journey that began last Advent, on November 27, the evangelist Matthew will become our gospel guide us for the next church year.

Luke will lead us through those first weeks of November with stories that help us think hard about what it is to be a disciple of Jesus. We'll celebrate All Saints, and Christ the King Sundays as the church year draws to a close and the season changes.

In Advent, we begin again with Matthew as we consider the old, old hopes for a Messiah. Our prayers still rise in longing for things to be set right, for "justice and peace to kiss". We celebrate the answer to those deep prayers at Christmas, highlighting the joy we know in Christ and yet remembering that for so many, joy is elusive. We will offer a Blue Christmas service at Christ the King, where we worship in hope and trust while not denying the difficulties and sadness that many of us feel in this season.

I will offer Bible study of the Advent texts after church beginning November 27<sup>th</sup>. Each week we will study the texts for next Sunday's worship.
