Let us be reminded this September that together as a church and as Christians, we are called to the vision of God's Work, Our Hands. That we are all created to participate in God's work on earth, to be signs of Christ in our community, making the love of God visible to all.



Join us in the Fellowship Hall after worship to put together turkey bologna and cheese sandwiches for our hungry neighbors. Our goal will be to make 500 sandwiches for the Walker Food Share. We'll need help to make this effort possible. Can you:

- · Help deliver the sandwiches on September 16?

#### Council Corner

#### **Council initiatives update:**

1.One-to-one conversations – this initiative is set to go through September, it is approximately 50% complete. Thank you to those who have already participated. Please say yes if asked, your feedback about CTK will help us plan for the future.

2.Sound System – Council approved an in-person survey to be performed over three Sundays in August & September. In addition, a technician visited with CTK on 8/29 to perform a system tune up and discuss possible upgrades and improvements.

I'd also like to report on some Ministry Team initiatives.

1.Discipleship – Getting ramped up for the start of Sunday School and putting together a request for funds for better chairs for the youth and other sitting options in the youth gathering room such as bean bag chairs for gatherings and videos.

2.Worship – Worship team has planned the worship services through the Advent Season.

3.Property – The Property Team performed an inventory of the windows to prioritize which windows need the most attention first. While the majority of windows are in good shape, the ones in the sanctuary are likely going to need to be addressed first. The team is also looking into updating the pulley system for the sanctuary banners.

A special thank you to all the ministry teams and the important work they do to keep CTK running smoothly.

Finally, through July, income has exceeded expenses by approximately \$4,400. This is the first time in several years that income has exceeded expenses at this point in the year. Thank you for your continued strong financial support.
